Howdy all,

Well its getting close to the holidays and the reason I know this it is TURKEY SHOOT TIME. We at the Board wish all of you a Happy Holiday.

There still has been some confusion about shooting for the silver. Last year we allowed you to select a category by March with the understanding this year (2012) it's chosen by January. A simple way to explain Shooting for the Silver is like this; if you sign up for a big match like Winter Range. During the course of Winter Range you have a birthday, can you change categories in the middle of the shoot to your age category? Shooting for the Silver is a match within a match, once you decide to declare a category, that is the one you shoot for the entire year. It doesn't mean you cant shoot another category if you want, however it will not count for the Silver.... Each year the board is faced with potential exceptions to the rules. Well I can tell you, the only exceptions are, a medical reason requiring a change in categories to continue shooting, or you are the only one in your category being you have to beat someone to get a silver.

The rules, like many we have in SASS were put in place to allow club members a chance to compete at a fair level. In the past SFS had to be declared in at the start of the year with a total of 8 matches required. Over time it fell to 6 matches and no declaring a category at the first of the year. As the rules relaxed, it was discovered some shooters would shoot a category, then change categories to help a buddy as a "spoiler". Or if a person wasn't doing so good in a category, they would switch categories and see which one they could win silver in with no regard for others. Well, I have to say the spirit of the game and the cowboy way aren't in mind when those of us who choose to be difficult when it comes to the rules of Shooting for the Silver.

Your board has done its best trying to accommodate all the members and make it fair in accordance with SASS Rules. If you have suggestions for the board or another way to fairly run Shooting for the Silver please bring it to our attention. For that matter if you have any suggestion feel free to submit it in writing and the board will be more than happy to review it and get back to you.

I hope this clarifies the rules.
