There were two items presented and discussed among the Territorial Governors in 2022.

The 2 items that were presented to the TG

Body for a vote did NOT pass. All 326 TG's were sent the email/voting link. The email had an 82.2% open rate and 54.9% voted (179).

#1 - Allow junior competitors to shoot gunfighter style in the junior category: No 128 = 71.5% Yes 51 = 28.5%

#2 – Revise BP standard:

No 129 = 72.5%

Yes 50 = 27.5%

Interestingly, the ACSA member vote was very nearly the same:

#1- No 78.6%

Yes 21.4%

#2- No 71.4%

Yes 28.6%
